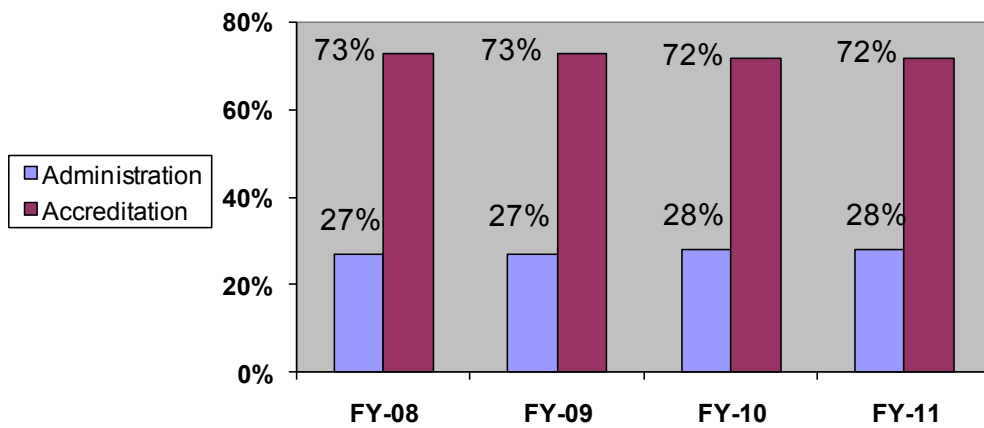

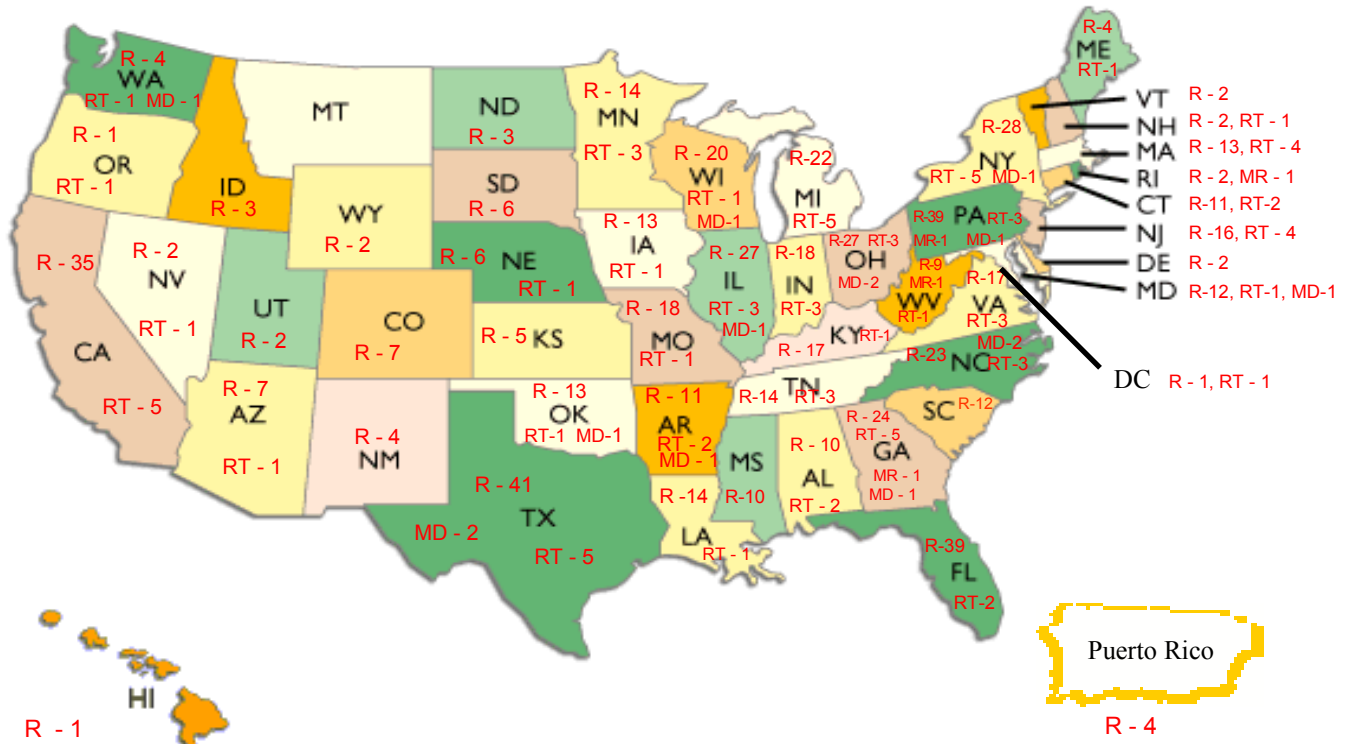

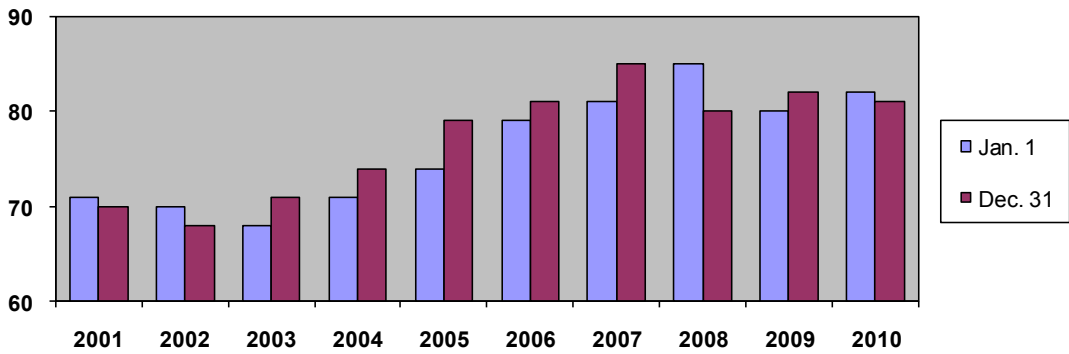
Radiography - 637 Programs

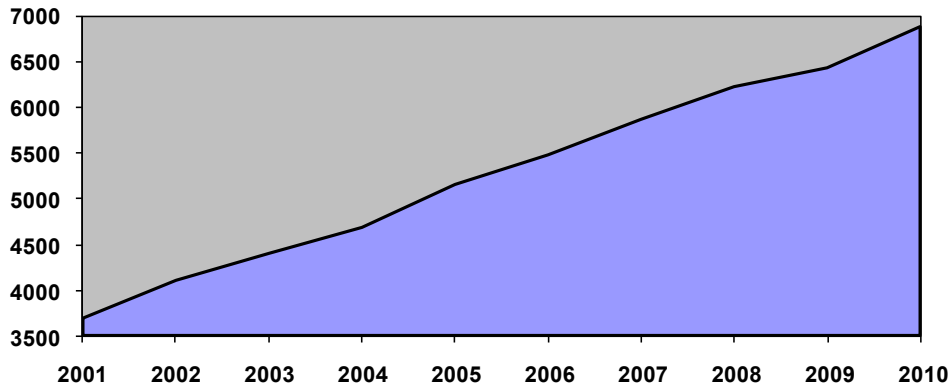

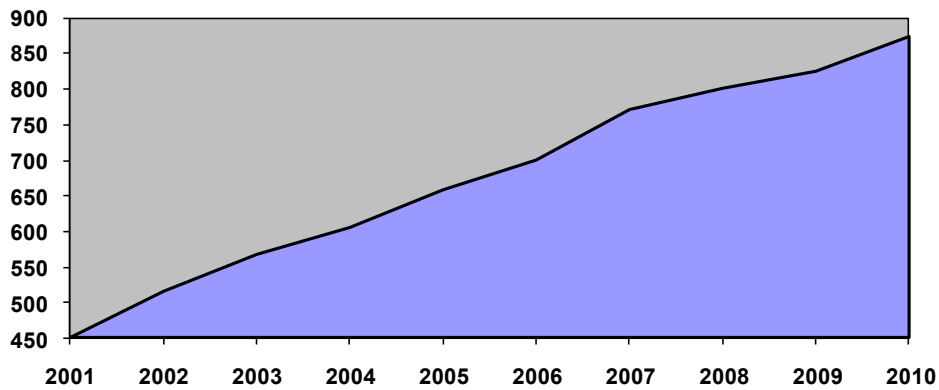

Radiation Therapy - 874 CESs

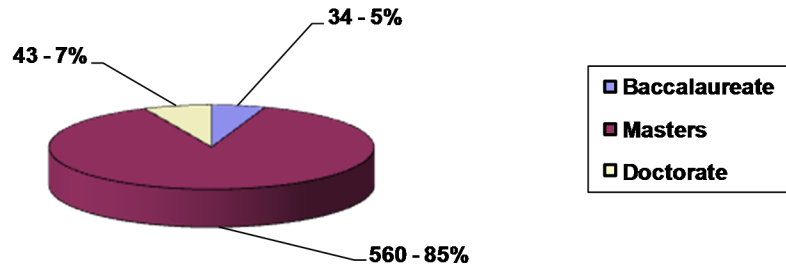


Medical Dosimetry - 99 CPSs

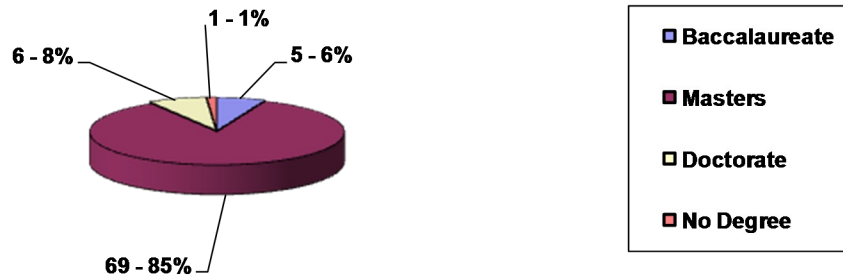

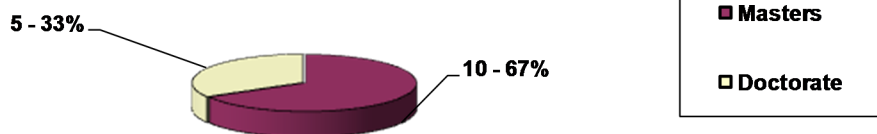

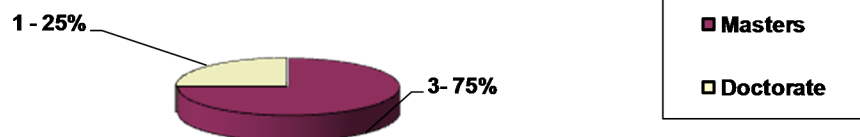
