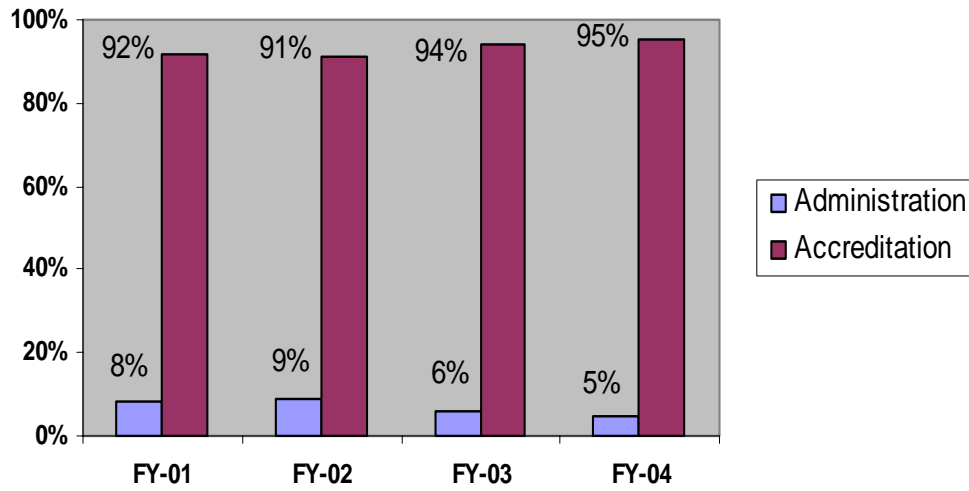

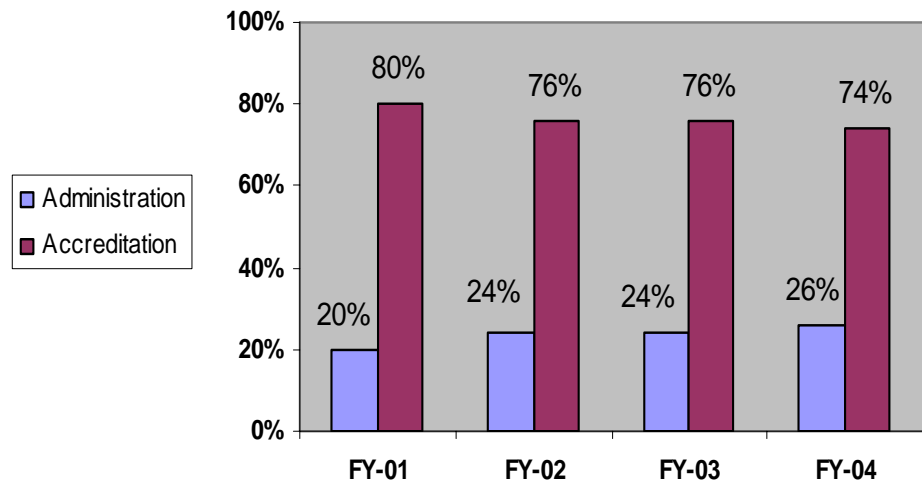

### Revenue



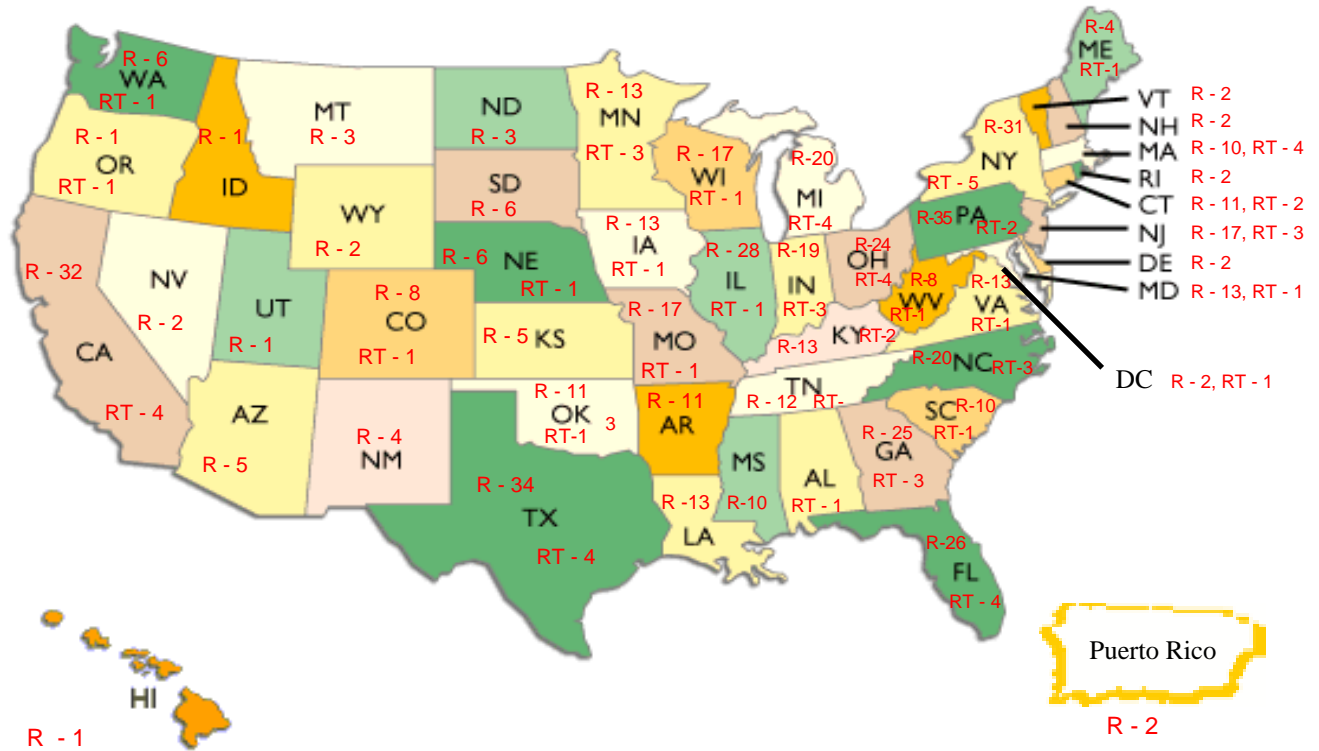

Radiation Therapy (RT)

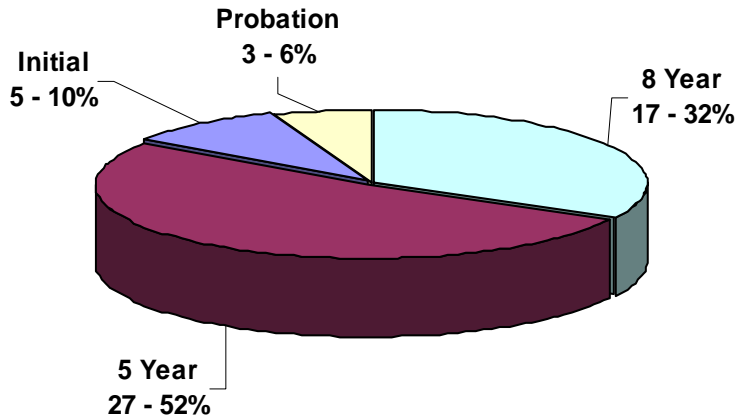

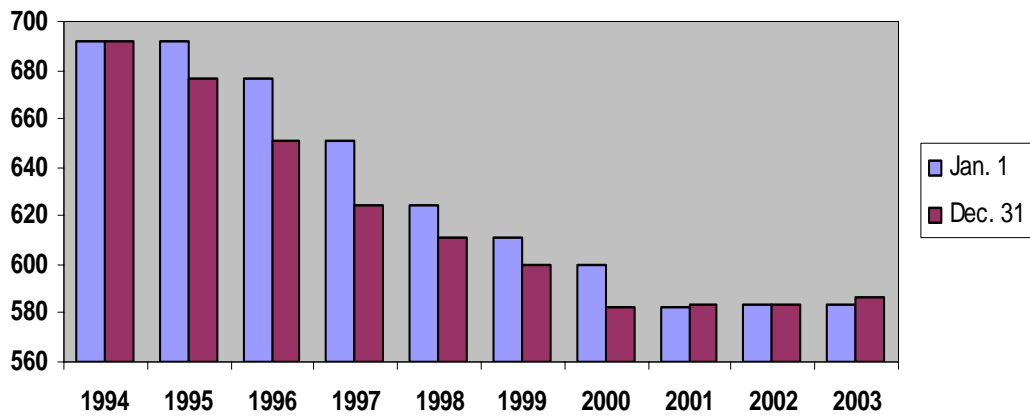

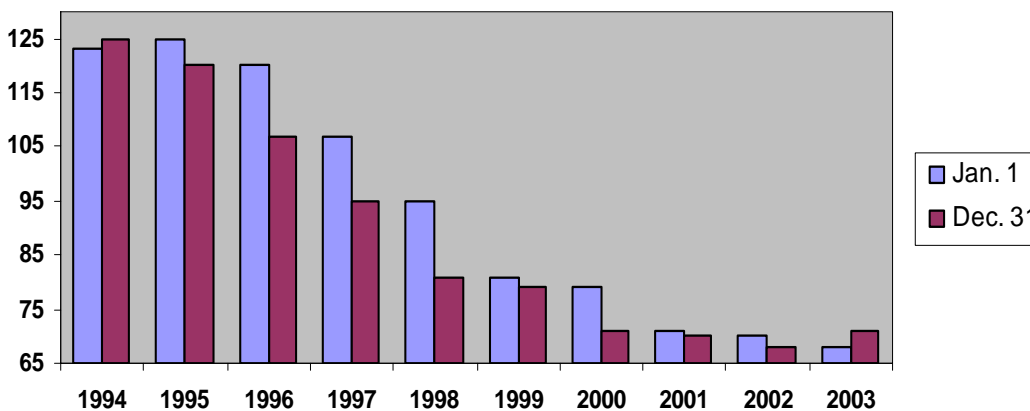
### Radiography - 587 Programs

### Radiation Therapy - 71 Programs

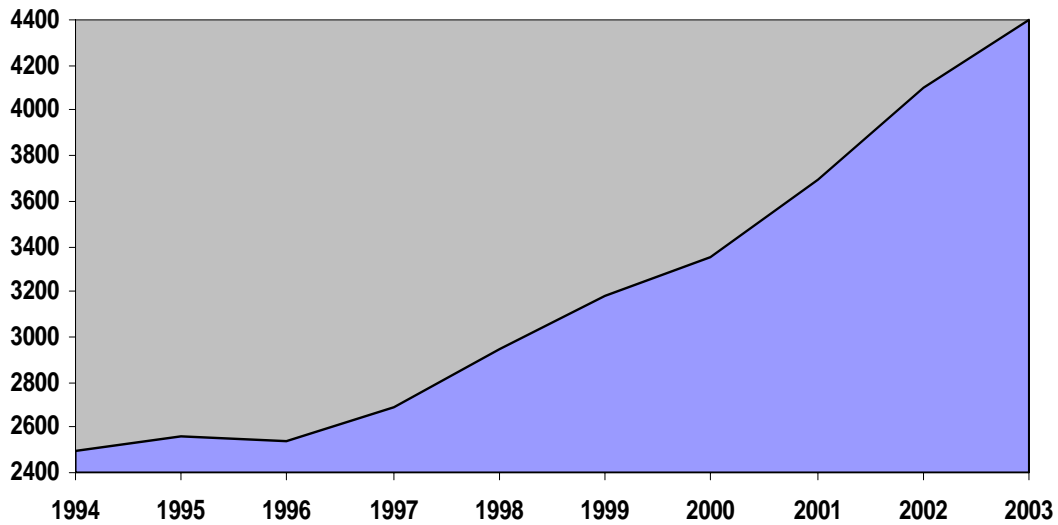

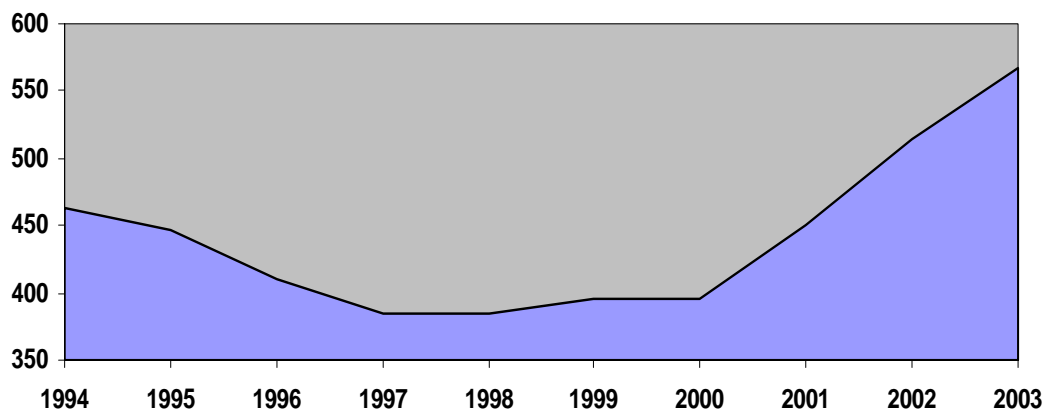

Radiography - 4,401 CESSs

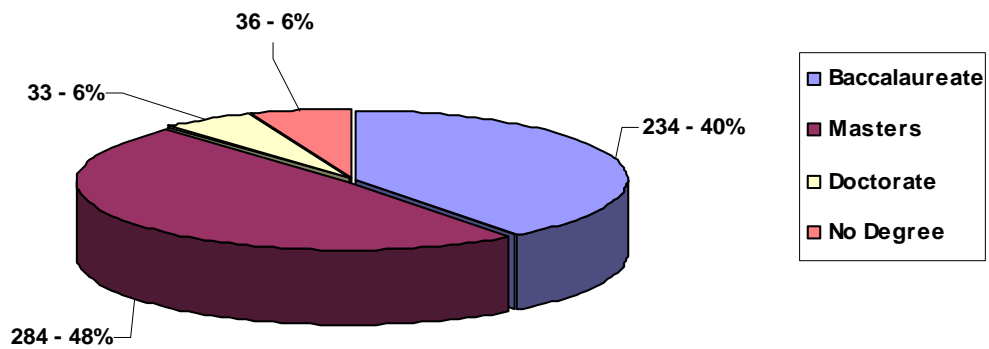


Radiation Therapy - 567 CESSs

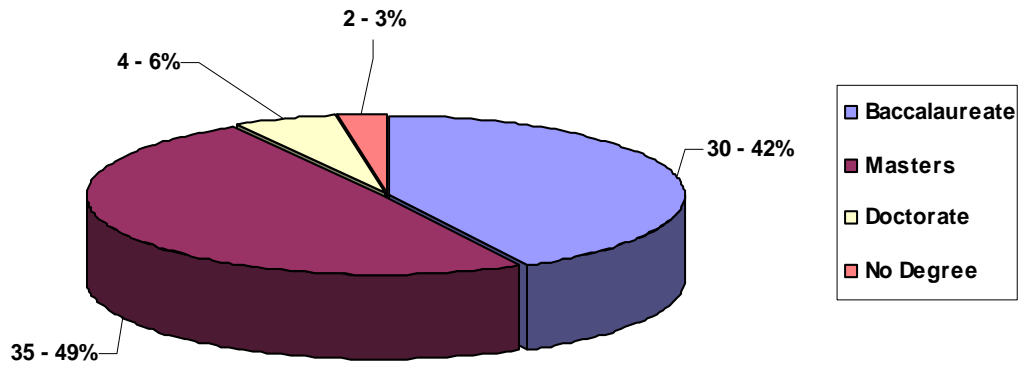
