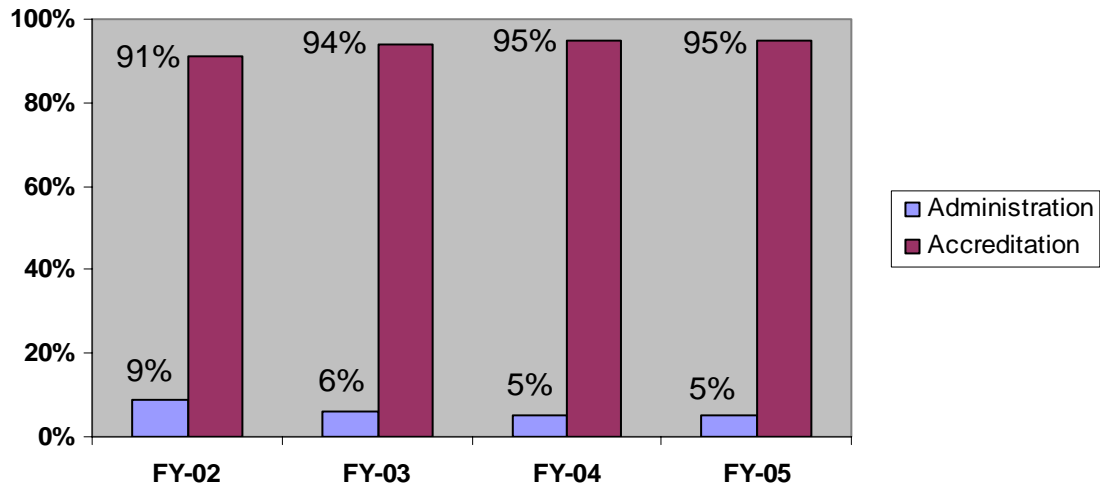

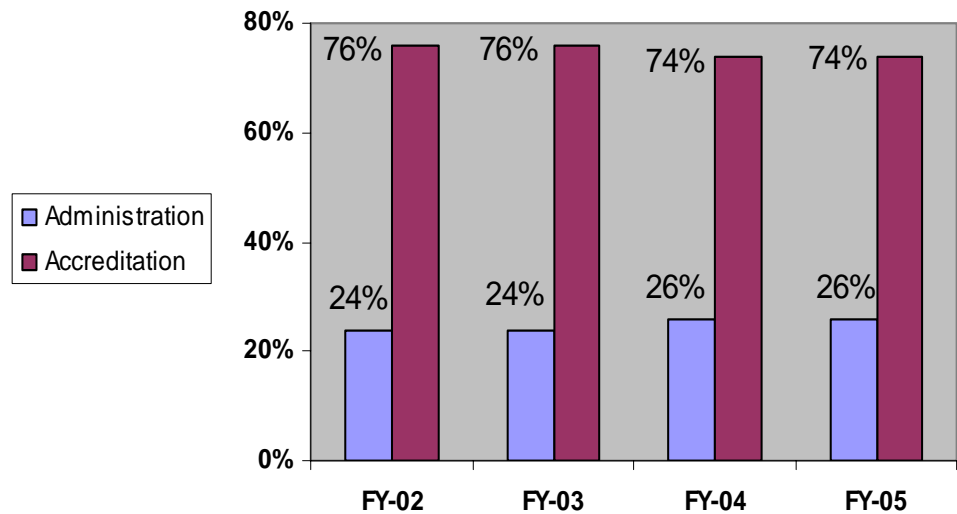

Revenue



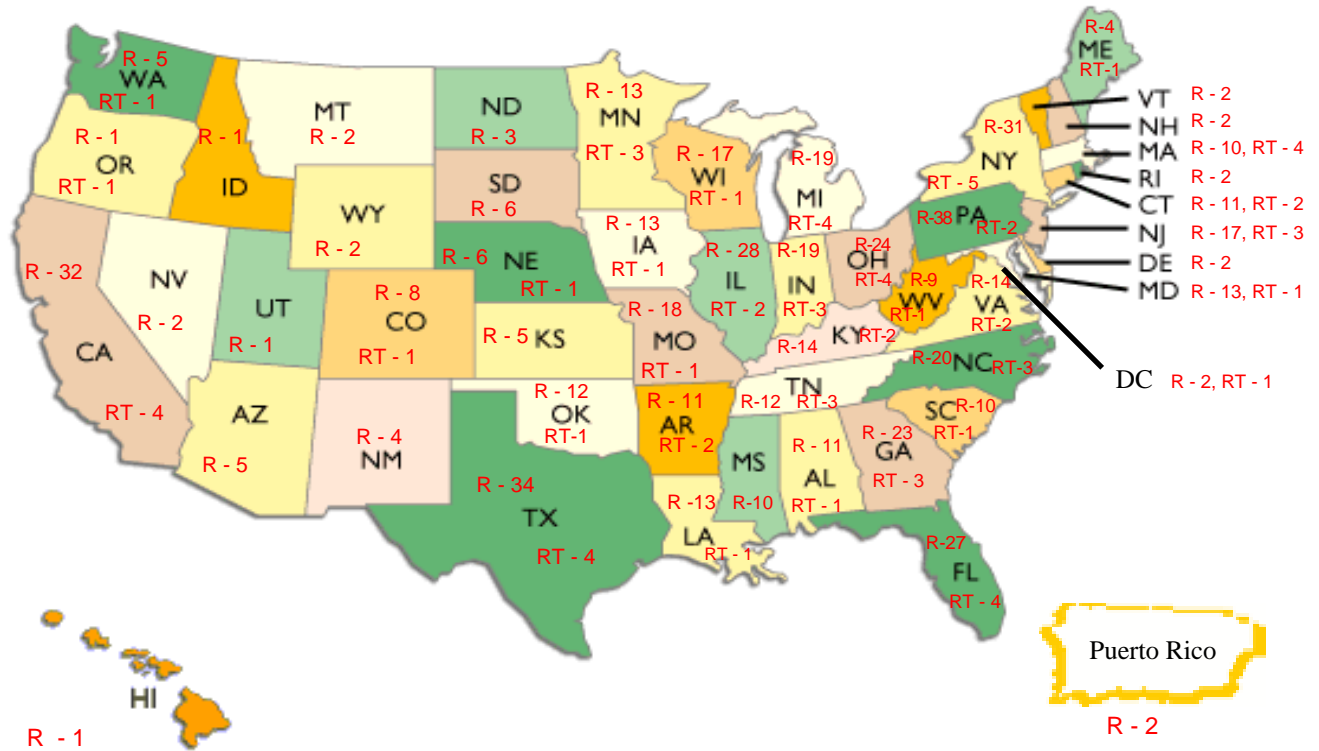

Radiation Therapy (RT)

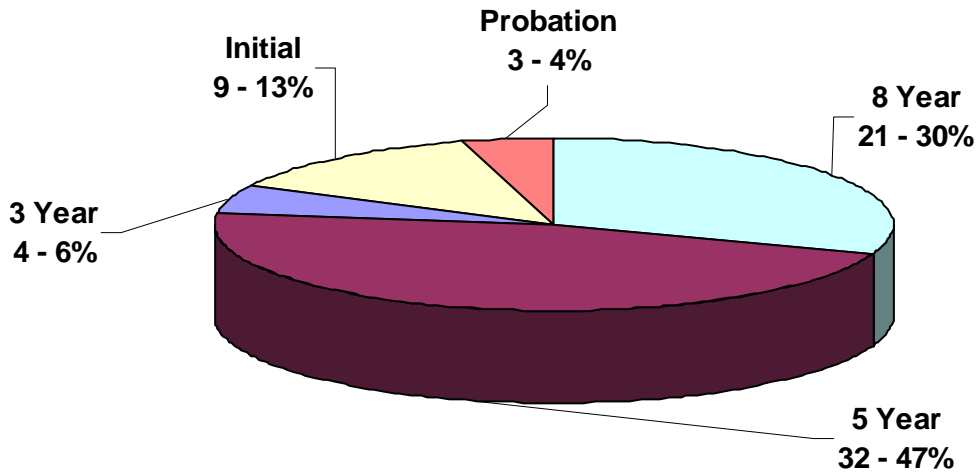

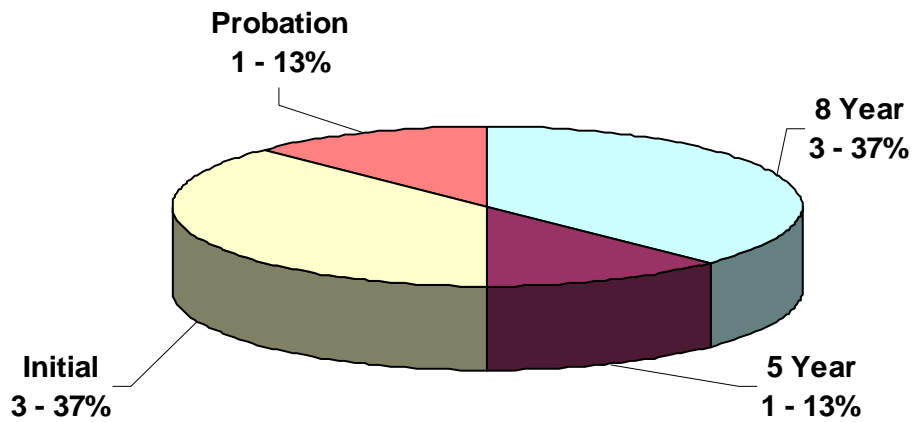

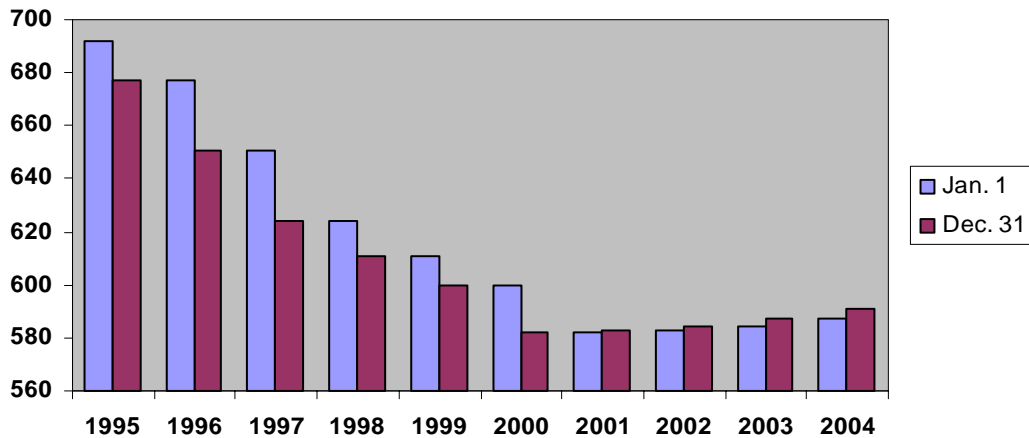

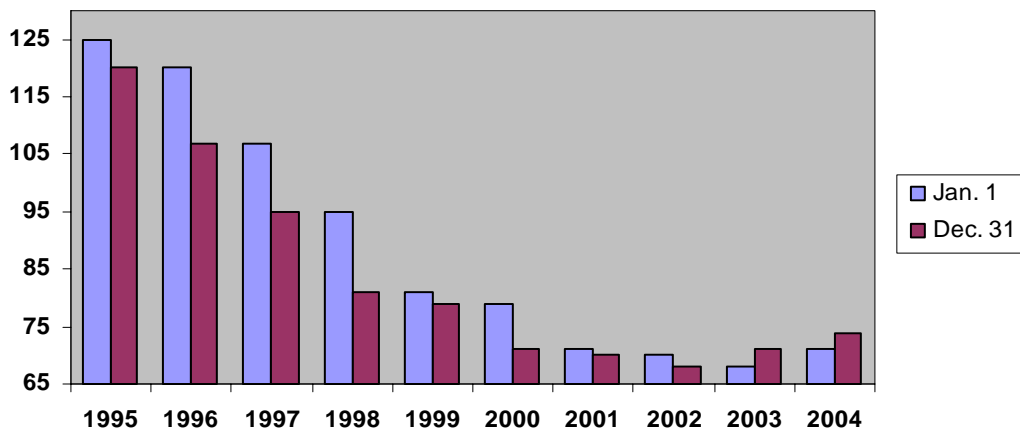
Radiography - 591 Programs

Radiation Therapy - 74 Programs

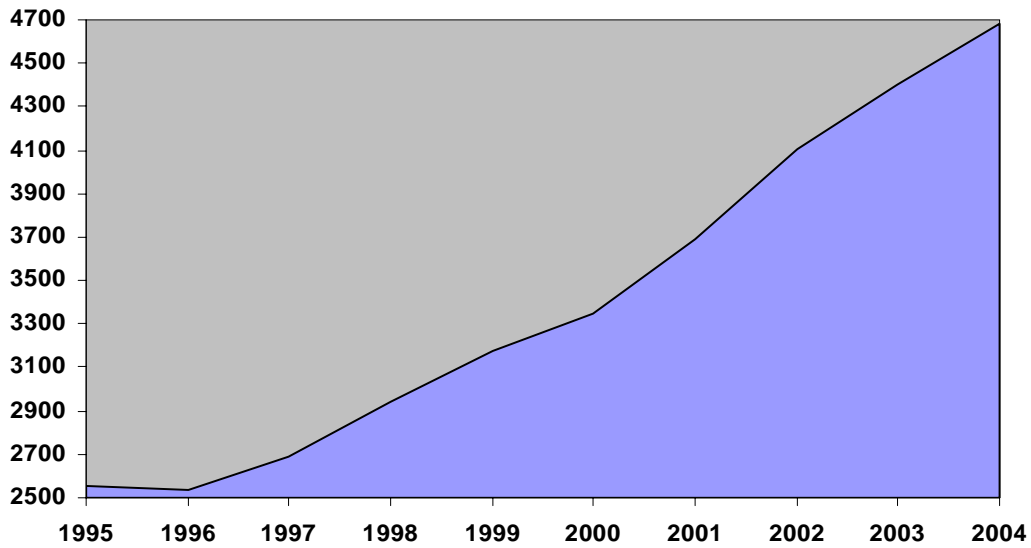


Net Percent - Gain/Loss

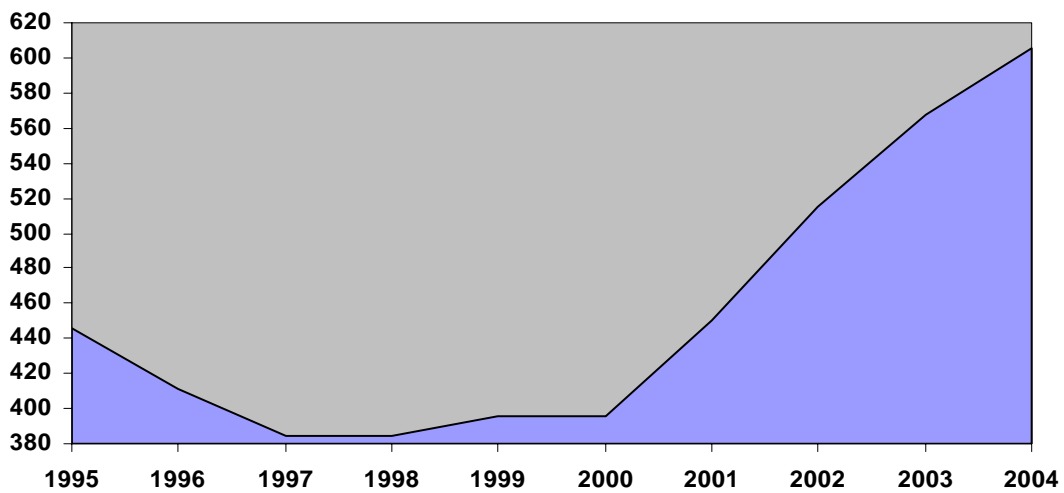

Radiography - 4,686 CESs

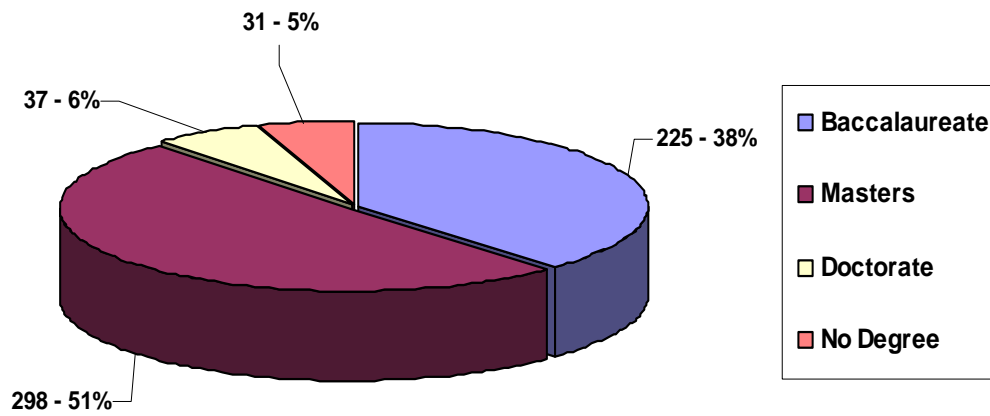


Radiation Therapy - 605 CESs

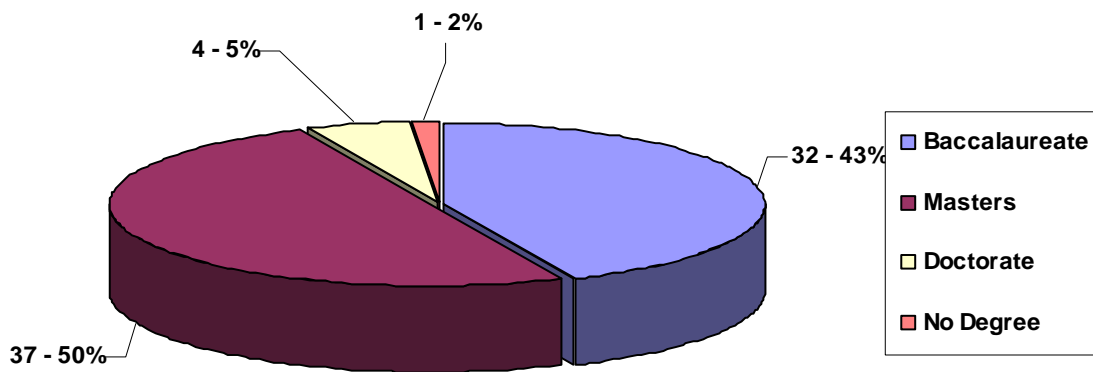
