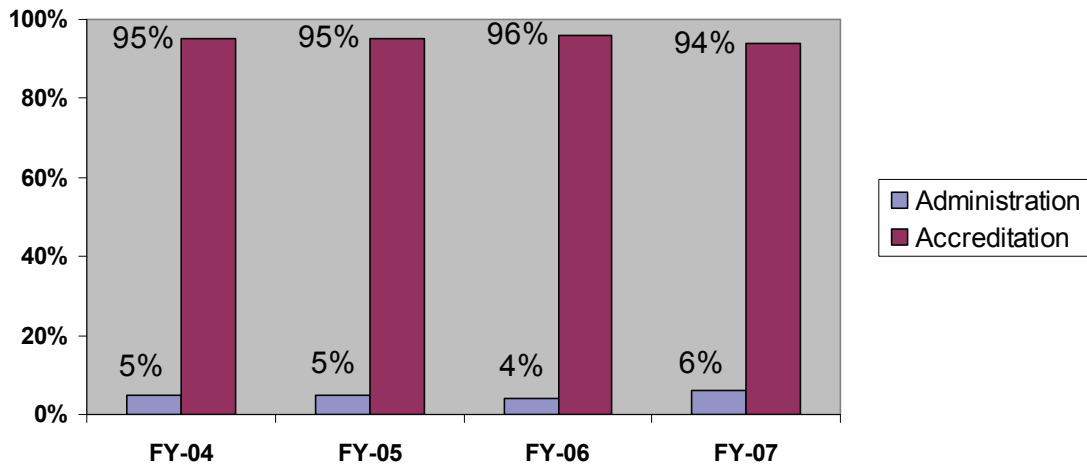

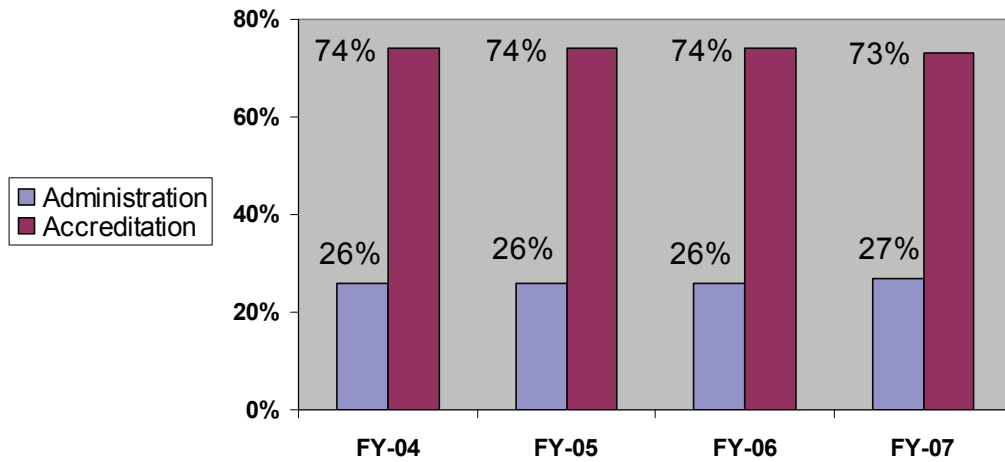

Expense

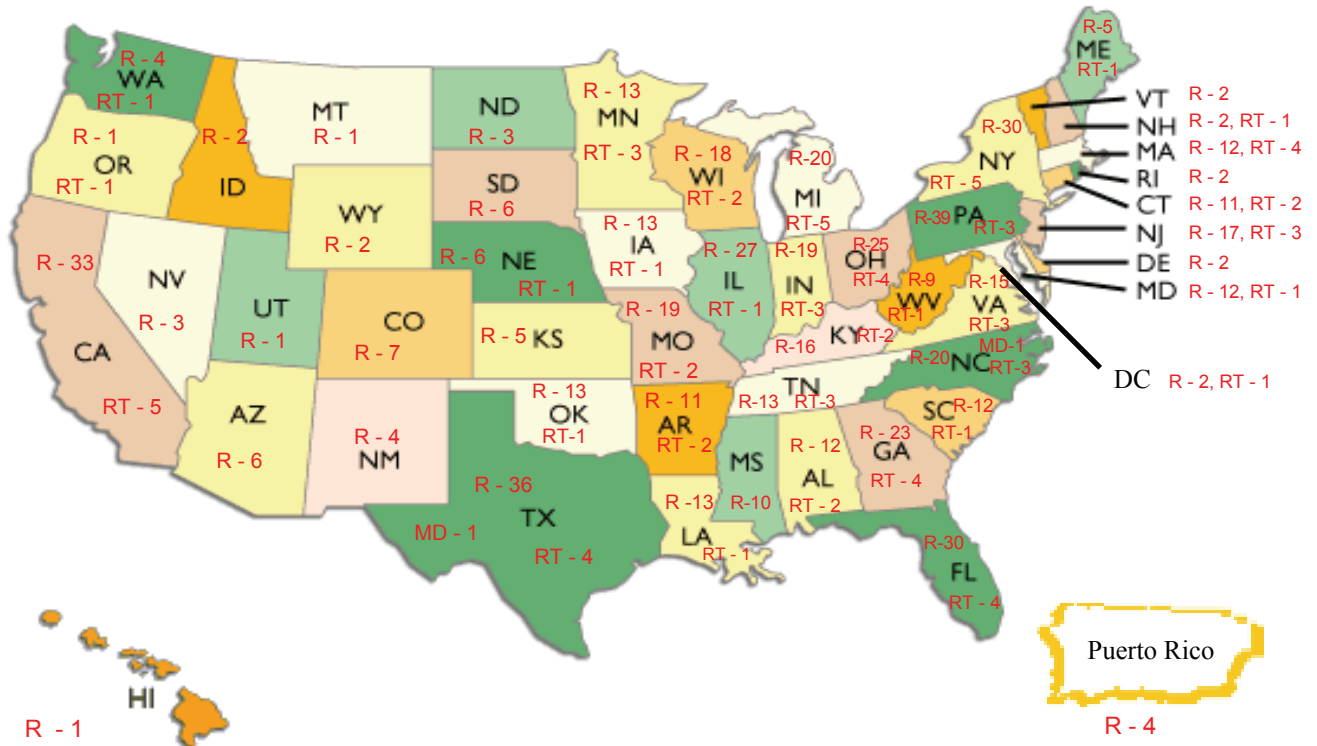


Number of Programs by State

Medical Dosimetry (MD)

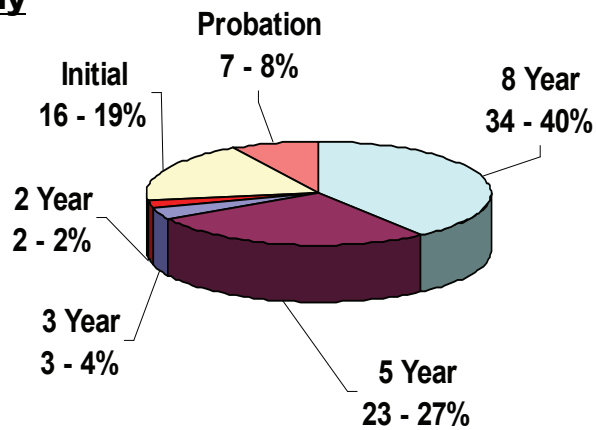

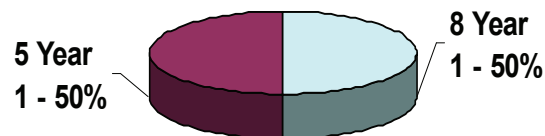

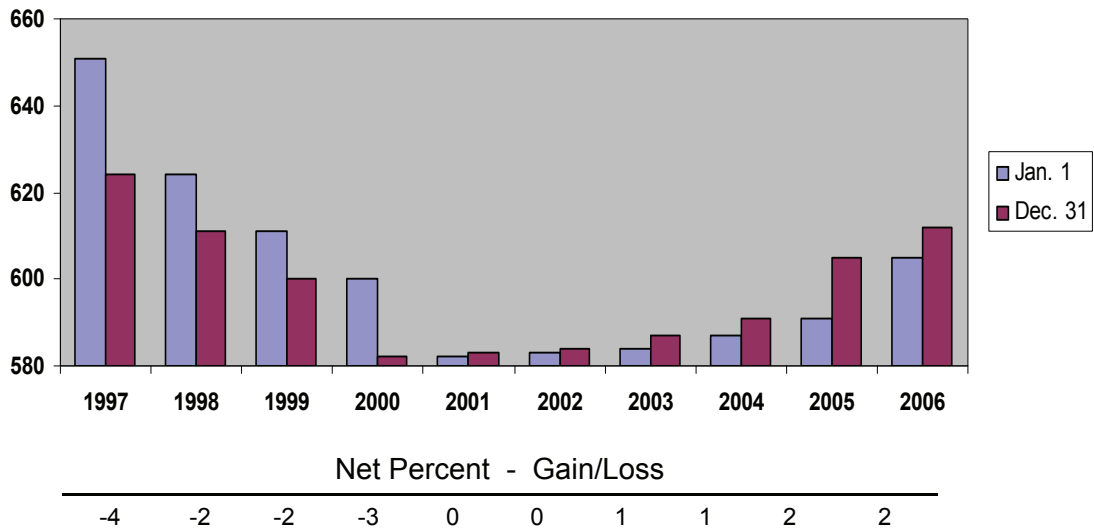

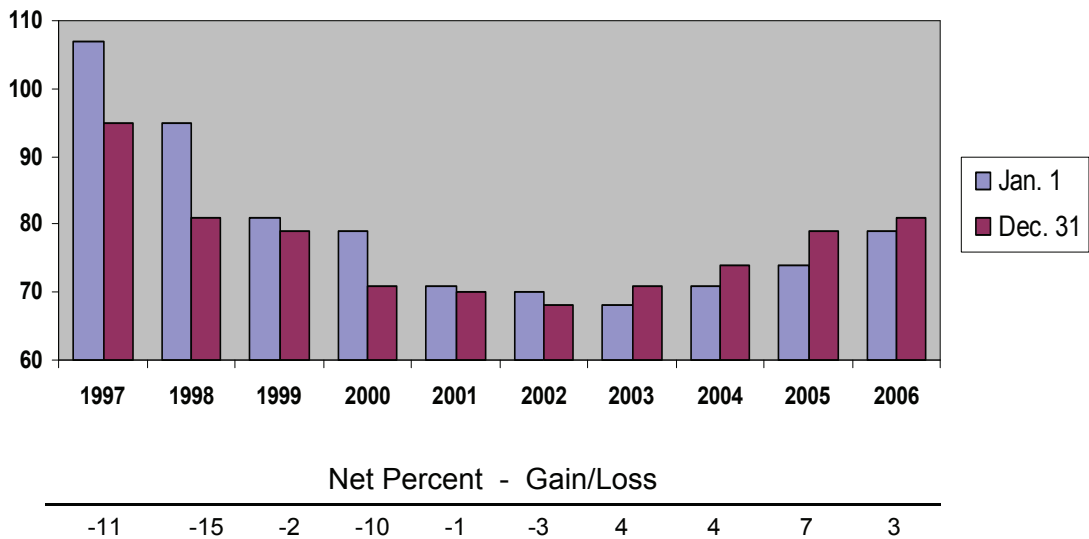

Radiography - 612 Programs

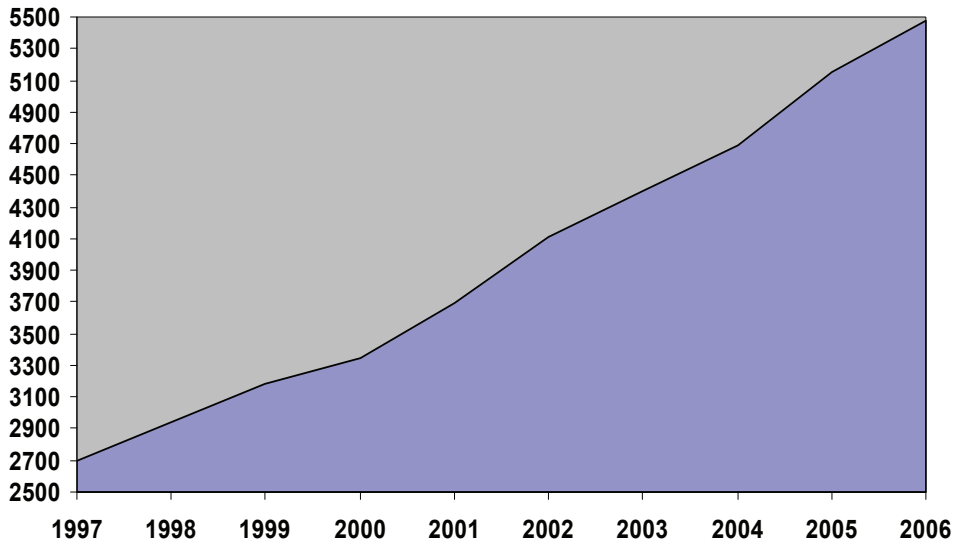


Radiation Therapy - 81 Programs

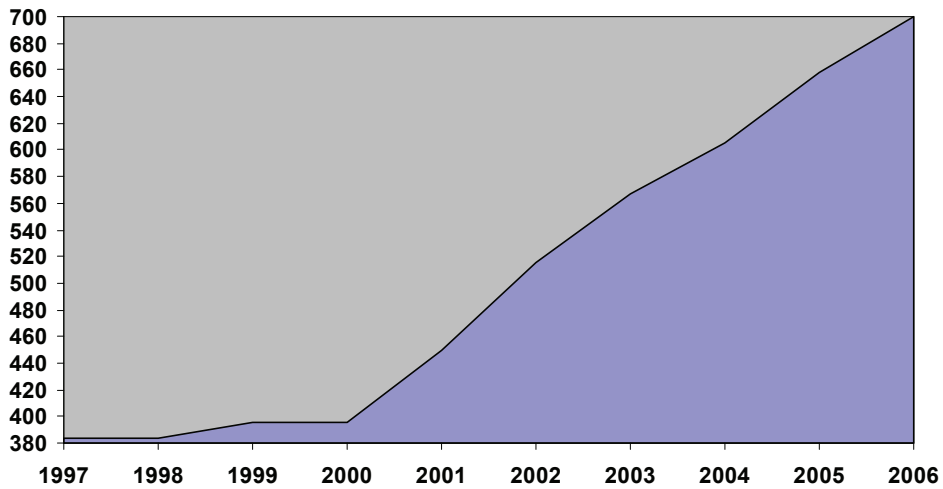


Number of Clinical Education/Practice Settings

Radiography - 5,482 CESs



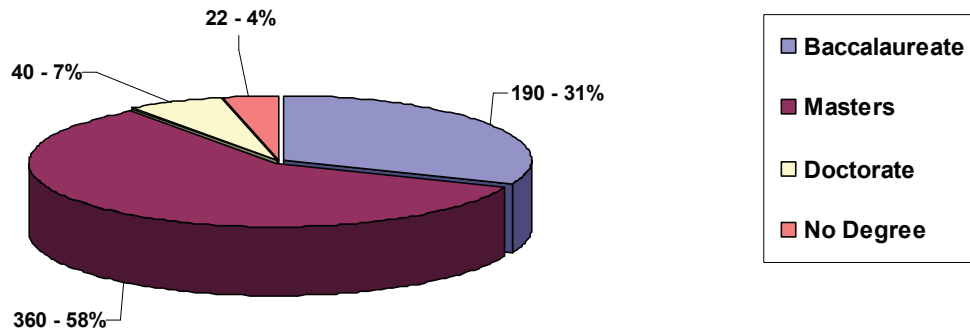
Radiation Therapy - 700 CESs



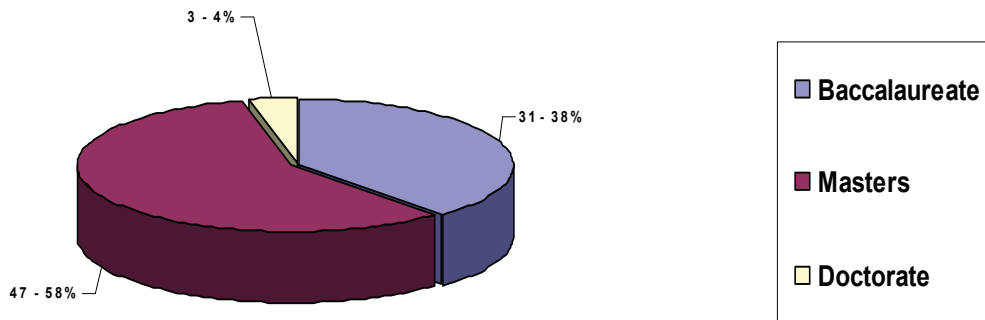
Medical Dosimetry - 8 CPSs

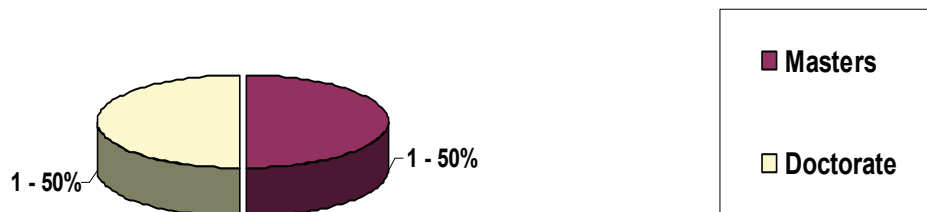
