Dear Mr. Slagle:

The Teach-Out Plan in support of the closure of the associate degree radiography program, which includes a distance delivery option, sponsored by Rasmussen University - Central Pasco was considered at the January 18, 2022 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. Specialized accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences.

The Teach-Out Plan provides for the equitable treatment of students consistent with applicable and relevant accreditation standards. Accordingly, the JRCERT took the following action:

APPROVAL OF TEACH-OUT PLAN.

The program is advised that it must maintain compliance with all accreditation standards until program closure.

JRCERT records will continue to identify the program as accredited until the date of program closure, March 18, 2023. Students that complete program requirements by March 18, 2023 will be considered graduates of a JRCERT-accredited program.

This voluntary withdrawal of accreditation will be affirmed by the JRCERT at the March 2023 Committee meeting. The program is requested to destroy the Certificate of Accreditation for the sponsor and all Certificates of Recognition for the clinical settings after March 18, 2023. The program is responsible for all accreditation fees until program closure.
