## RE: Program #0508 Previous Accreditation Status: 8 Years Most Recent Site Visit: 01/2017

Dear President South:

After review of the requested interim report, the continuing accreditation status of the associate degree radiography program sponsored by South College - Knoxville was considered at the May 25, 2021 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. Specialized accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2021)**. The JRCERT took the following action:

## MAINTENANCE OF ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF EIGHT YEARS.

The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the First Quarter of 2025.

The program is advised that students must be provided their radiation exposure report within thirty (30) school days following receipt of the data. The program is also advised to enhance documentation that clinical preceptors and clinical staff are apprised of supervision policies annually. The program is further advised that its systematic assessment plan must, at a minimum, contain two assessment tools per student learning outcome.

The program is finally advised that consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.600, the JRCERT reserves the right to conduct unannounced site visits of accredited programs. The sponsoring institution would be responsible for the expenses of any on-site evaluation.

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The Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology Directors and staff congratulate you and the program faculty for maintaining the maximum award of accreditation from the JRCERT and wish you continuing success in your efforts to provide a quality educational program.
