Dear Mr. Fitzgibbon:

After review of the requested progress report, the continuing accreditation status of the certificate and baccalaureate degree radiography program, which includes evening and weekend curricular tracks, sponsored by Kaiser Permanente School of Allied Health Sciences-Kaiser Medical Center - Richmond was considered at the April 5, 2019 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. Specialized accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2014)**. The JRCERT took the following action:

EXTENSION OF ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS.

This extension equates to an award of eight years of accreditation effective from the date of the most recent site visit.

An interim report will be required. The projected date for submission of the interim report is the Second Quarter of 2021. The JRCERT will provide program officials adequate notice of the due date for submission of the interim report. Based on the interim report, the JRCERT will determine if the accreditation award of eight years will be maintained or reduced and the continuing accreditation process expedited.

Based on this extension, the next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the Second Quarter of 2025.
