 Board of Directors Meeting
 October 2016

Greetings from the JRCERT:

We hope that you and your families are enjoying the fall season and preparing for the holidays. The JRCERT recently held its Fall Board of Directors meeting. The face-to-face meeting of the Directors was, as always, very productive. We would like to take this opportunity to highlight some of the key items from the meeting.

From January 1, 2016 to date, the Board has taken action on approximately 240 programs; following is a breakdown:

The Directors also took action on 47 interim reports. The remaining accreditation actions were progress reports and substantive changes.

Key Items from the Meeting:

- The JRCERT Petition for Continued Recognition by the United States Department of Education (USDE), submitted in May 2016, will be heard and defended at the February 2017 meeting of the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI).
- The JRCERT will soon begin work on the Interim Report for continued recognition by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), which will be due in 2017.
- Directors were advised by the Chief Executive Officer that the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS) has had their accreditation withdrawn by the USDE; however, since ACICS continues to be accredited by CHEA, the JRCERT does not need to take any action at this time with programs that have identified ACICS as the sponsoring institution accreditor.
- The current JRCERT Strategic Plan was reviewed/approved and a schedule was established to begin updating the plan at the April 2017 meeting.
- Board approved site visitor reappointments.
