The JRCERT is grateful for those who provided feedback on Draft 1. Draft 1 remains on the website for those wishing to perform a more thorough crosswalk; however, some noteworthy changes in Draft 2 are as follows:

- A full-time equivalent clinical coordinator is required if the program has more than 15 students enrolled in the clinical component of the program. (All documents)
- The direct supervision of students during surgical procedures. (Radiography documents)
- Three-year average credentialing examination pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within six months of graduation. (Excluding Medical Dosimetry documents)
- Three-year average credentialing examination pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt within twelve months of graduation. (Medical Dosimetry documents)
- Three-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within twelve months of graduation. (All documents)
- Programs must have access to a fully energized laboratory. (Radiography documents)


