



Summary of October 2015 Board Meeting

Greetings from the JRCERT:

We hope that you and your families are enjoying the fall season. The crisp weather and spectacular fall colors are making this a memorable time for us here in the Chicago area. The JRCERT recently held its Fall Board of Directors meeting. The meeting was very busy and we would like to take the opportunity to highlight some of the key elements of the meeting.

From January 1, 2015 to date, the Board has taken action on approximately 232 programs; following is a breakdown:

The Directors also took action on 62 interim reports. The remaining accreditation actions were progress reports and substantive changes.

Wolfman, M.D., whose term will expire at the conclusion of the April 2016 meeting. Beverly Felder, M.P.A. will replace Susan Hatfield, Ph.D. as public member, whose term will expire at the conclusion of the April 2016 meeting.
